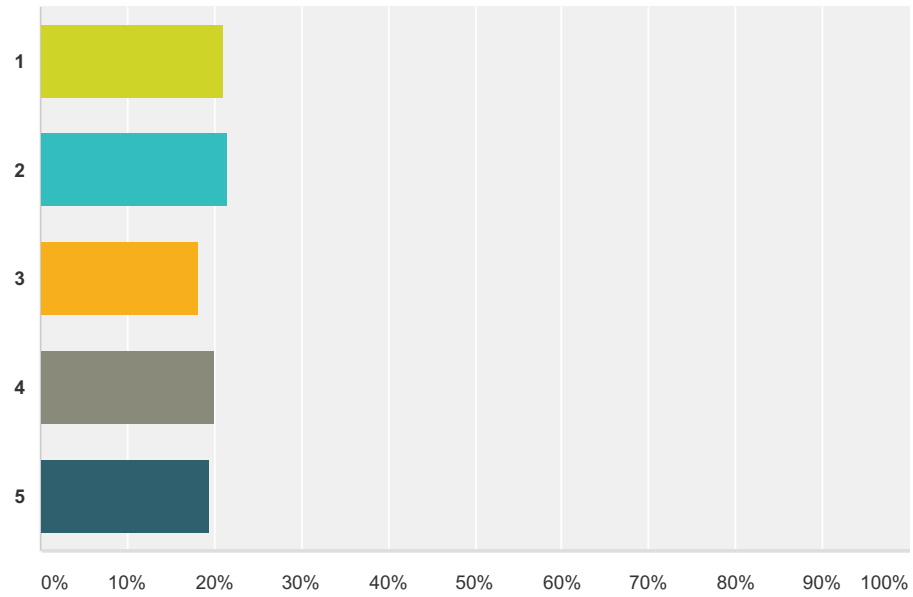

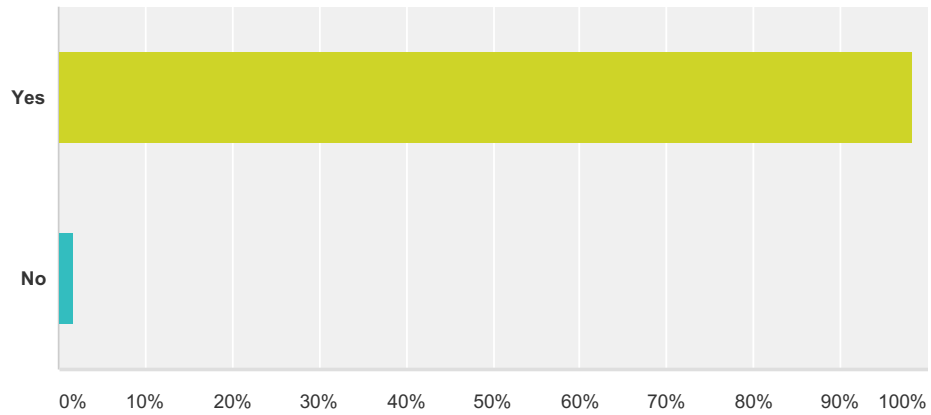

Q2 Are you a Catholic?

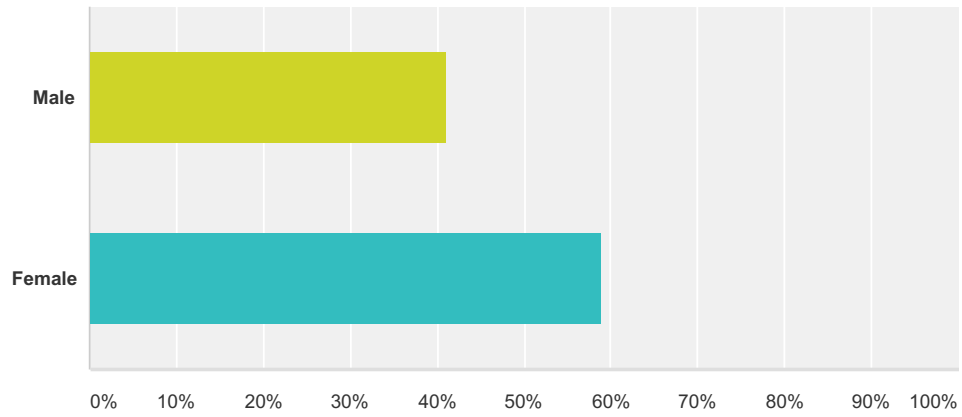

Q3 Gender?

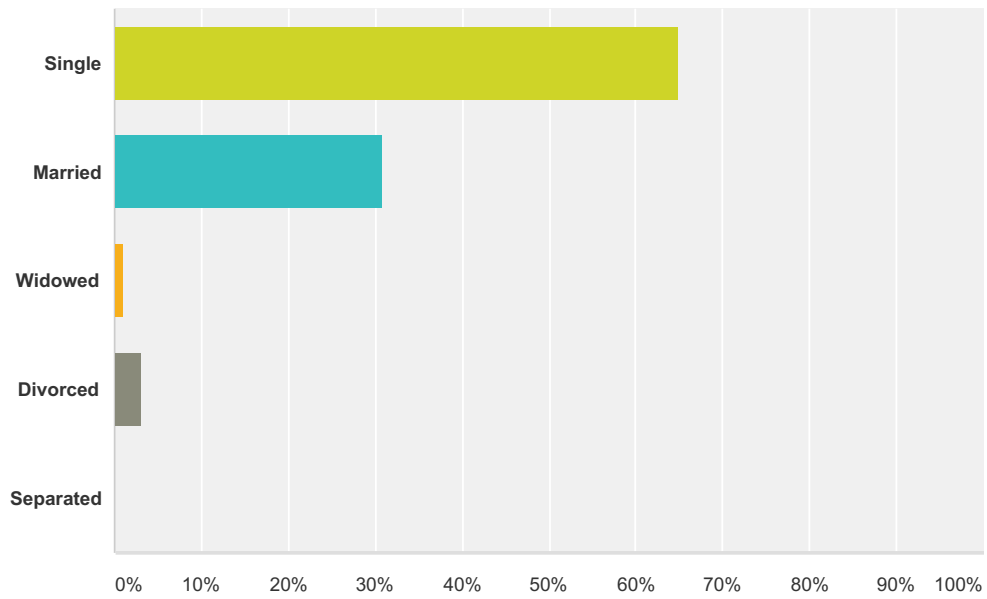

Q4 Marital Status?

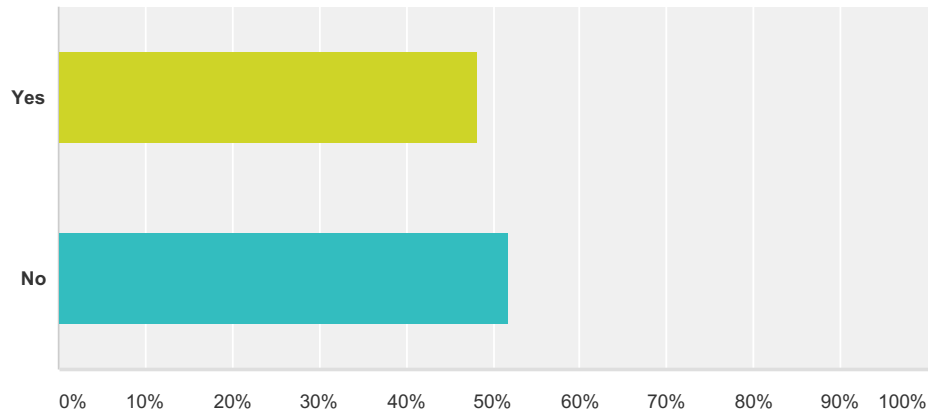

Q5 Are you a registered parishioner?

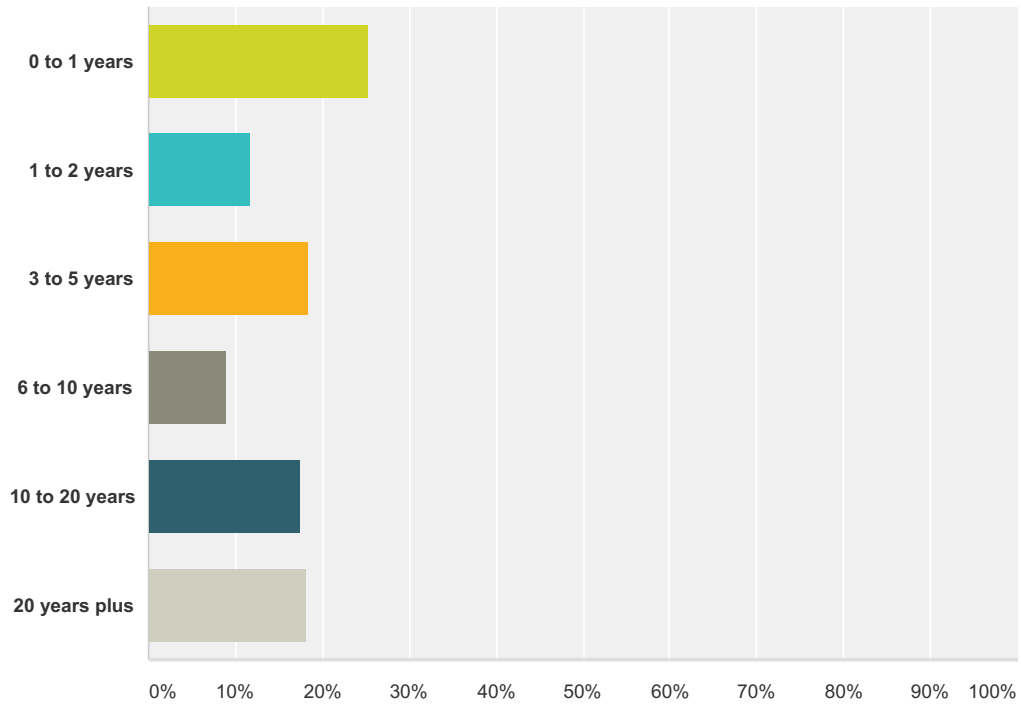

Q6 How long have you been a parishioner?

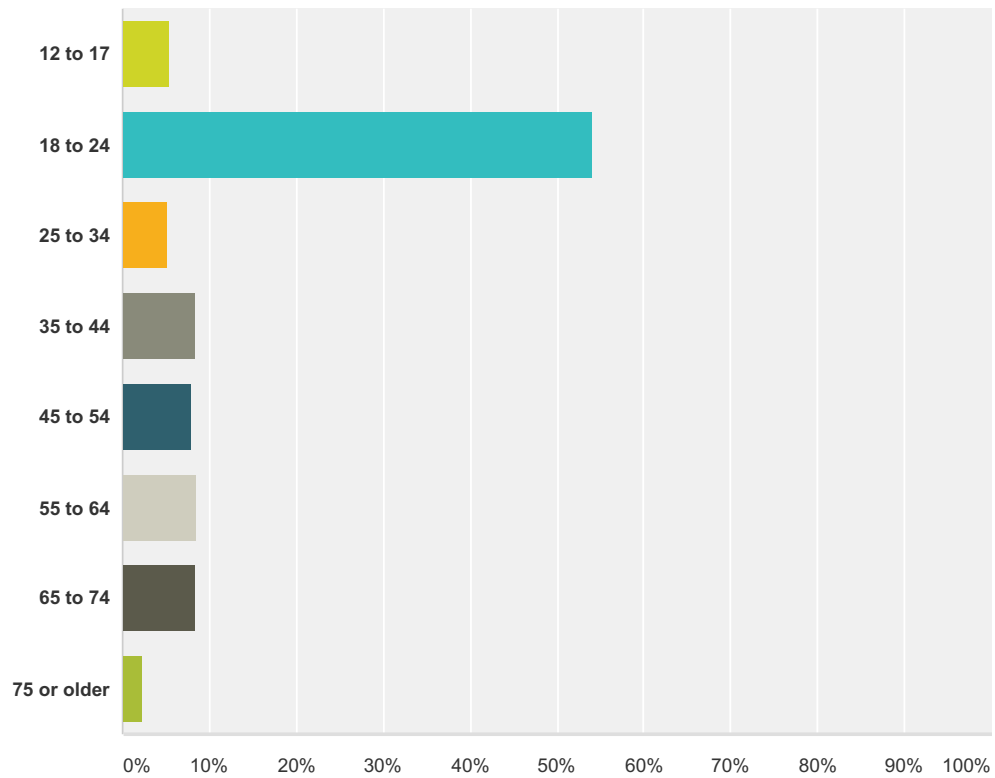

Q7 What is your age?

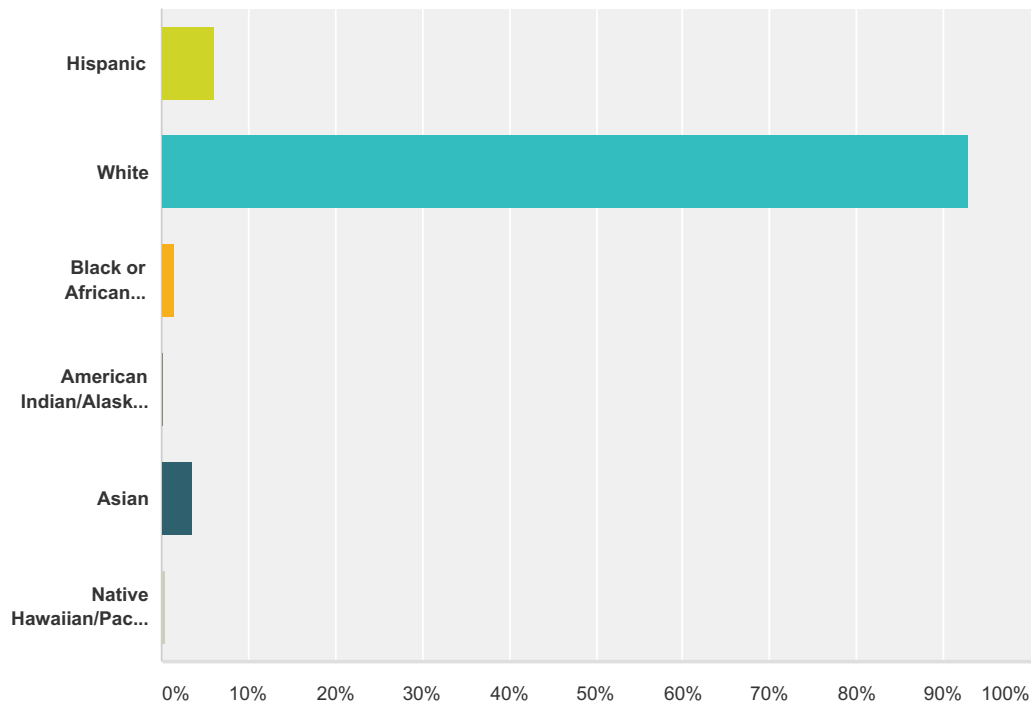

Q9 Race/ethnicity? (Please select all that apply.)

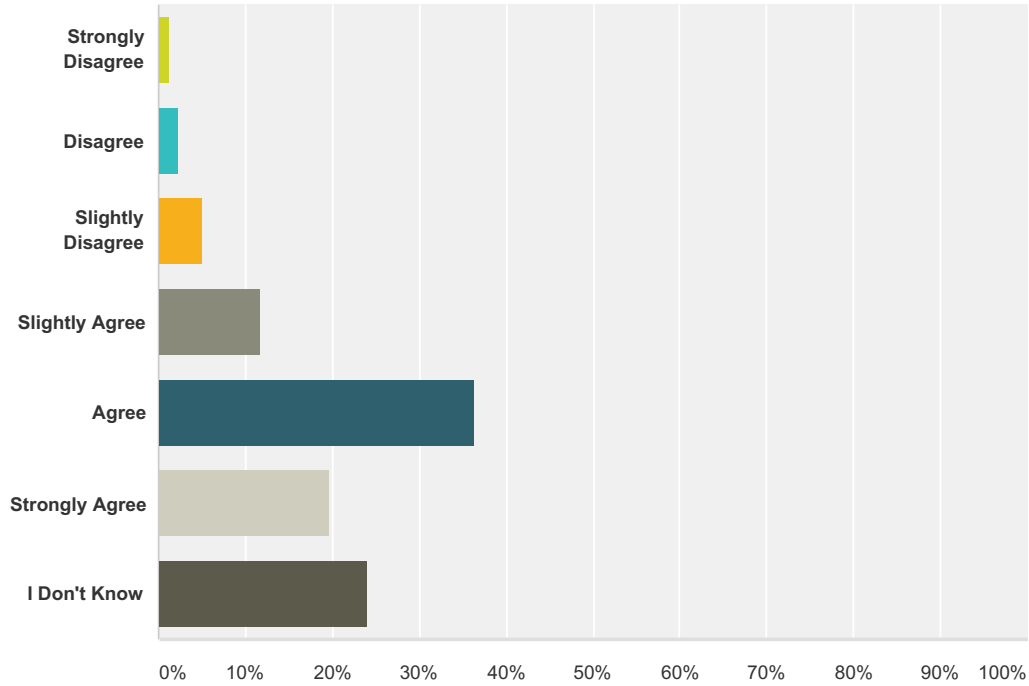

Q10 The Parish regularly identifies parishioners' talents and interests and invites their use in Parish activities.

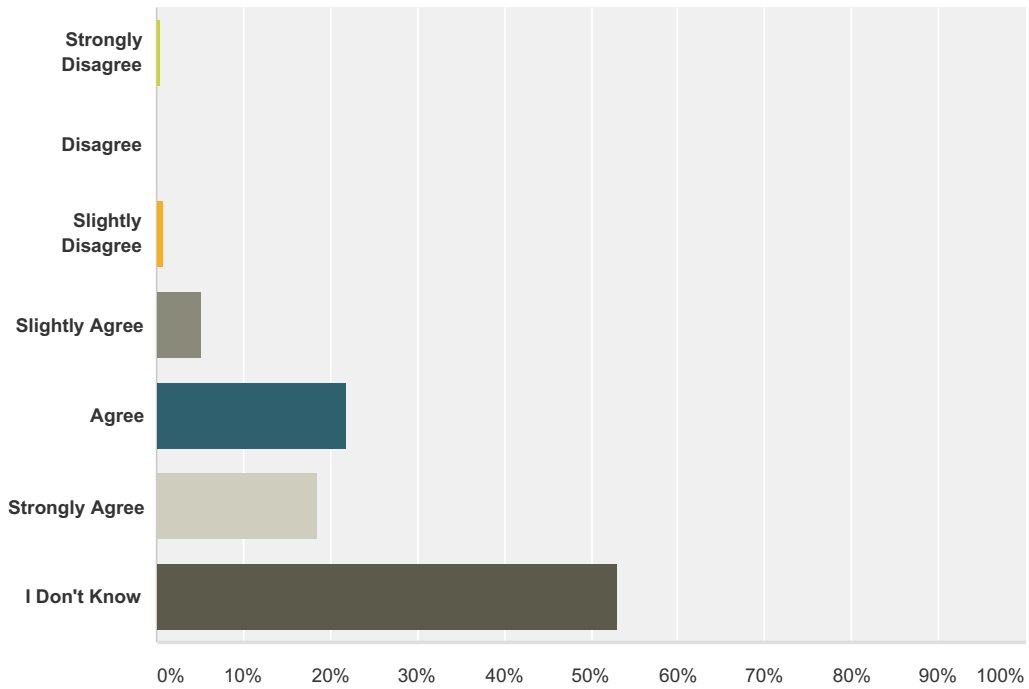

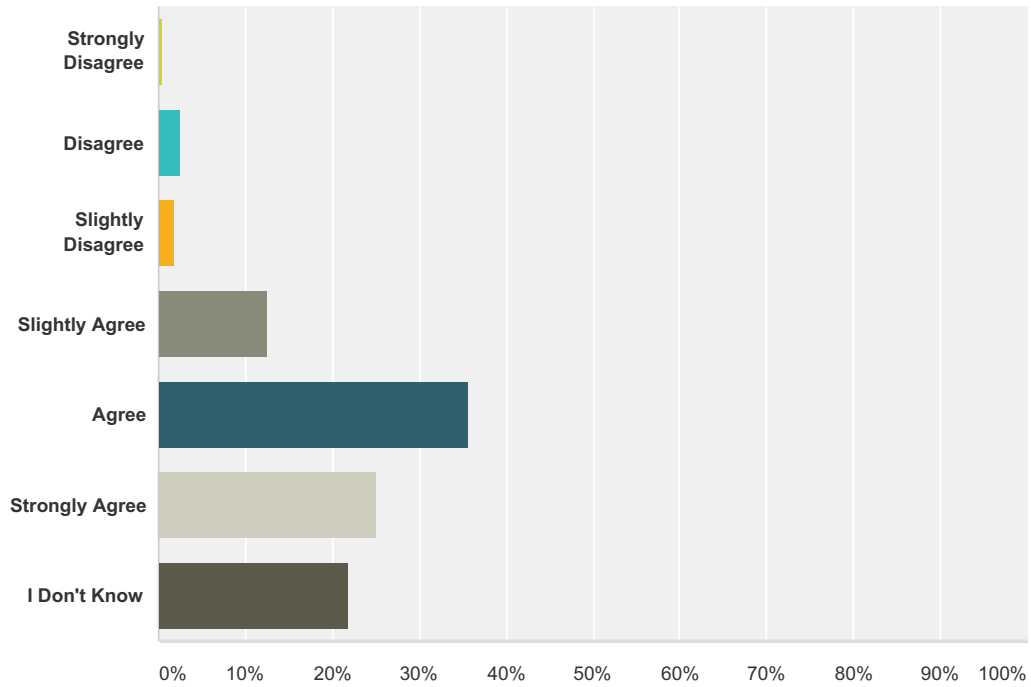

Q12 The Pastor and Parish leaders communicate regularly and effectively to parishioners about programs and the use of Parish resources.

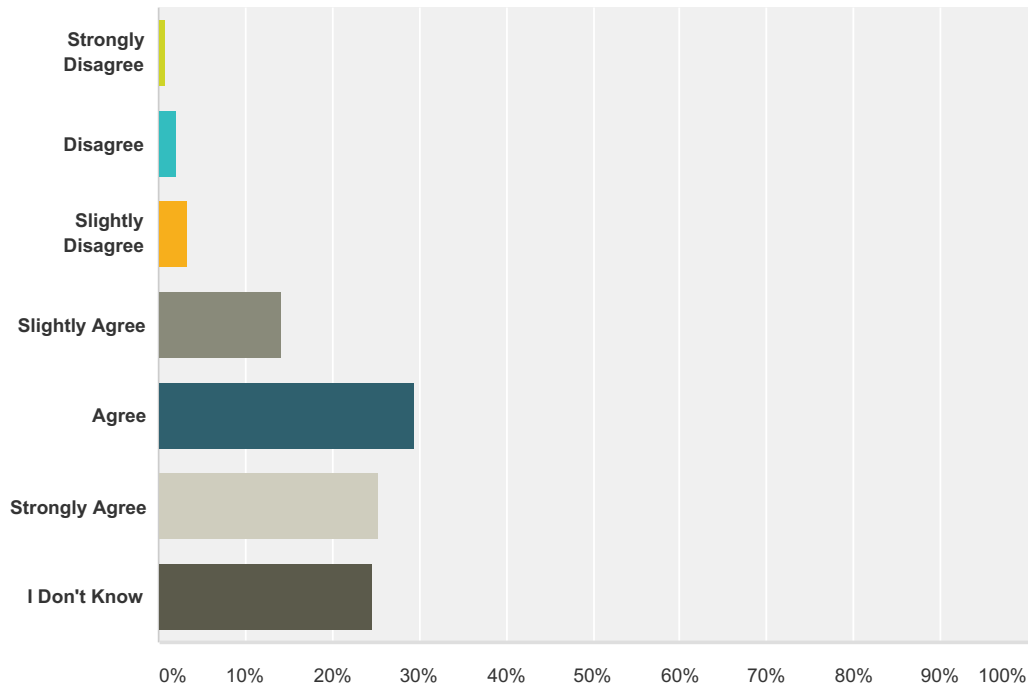

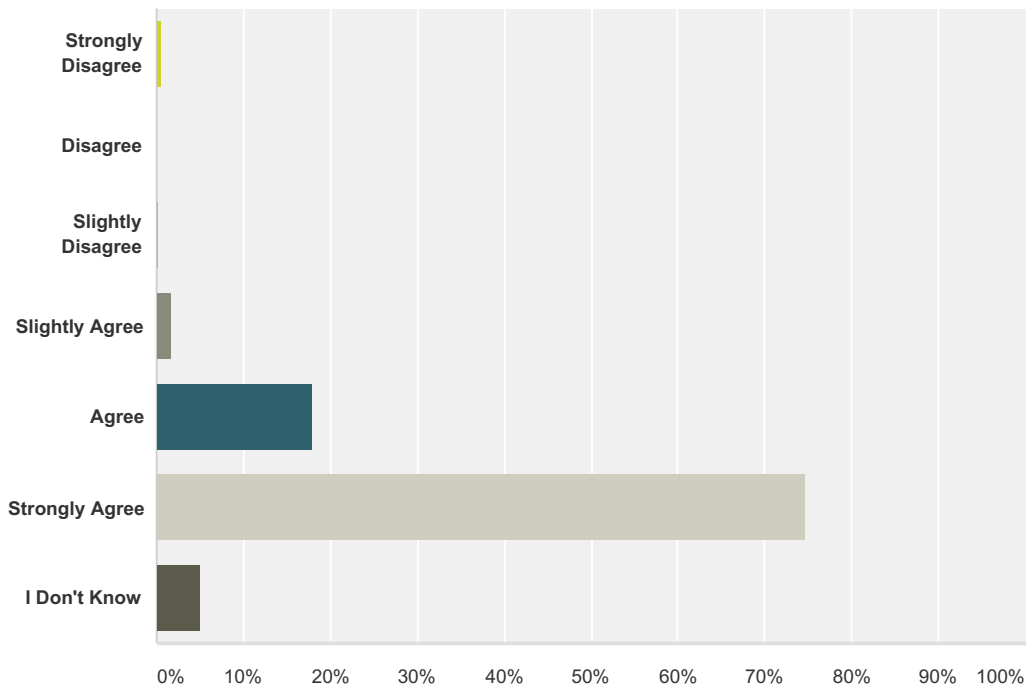

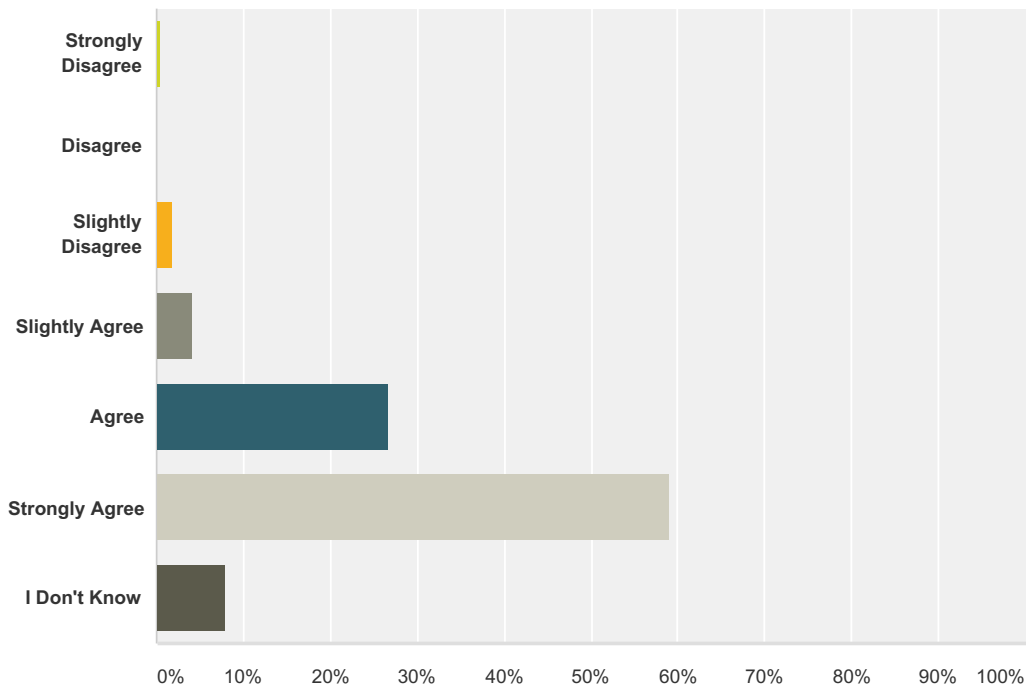

Q15 Parish facilities are appropriate for the present and future needs of the Parish.

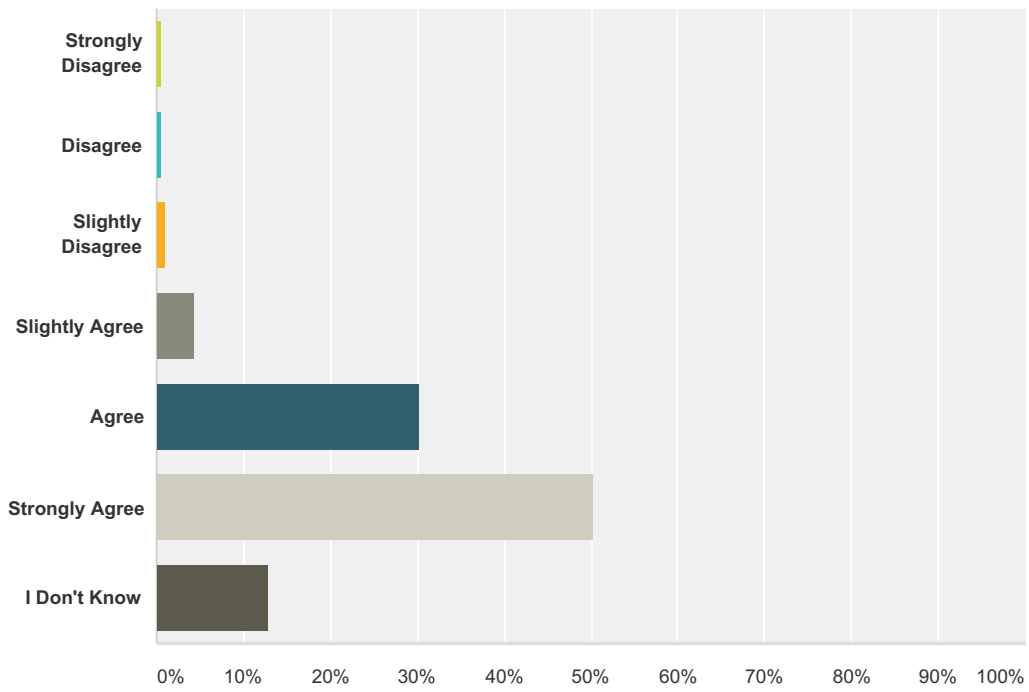

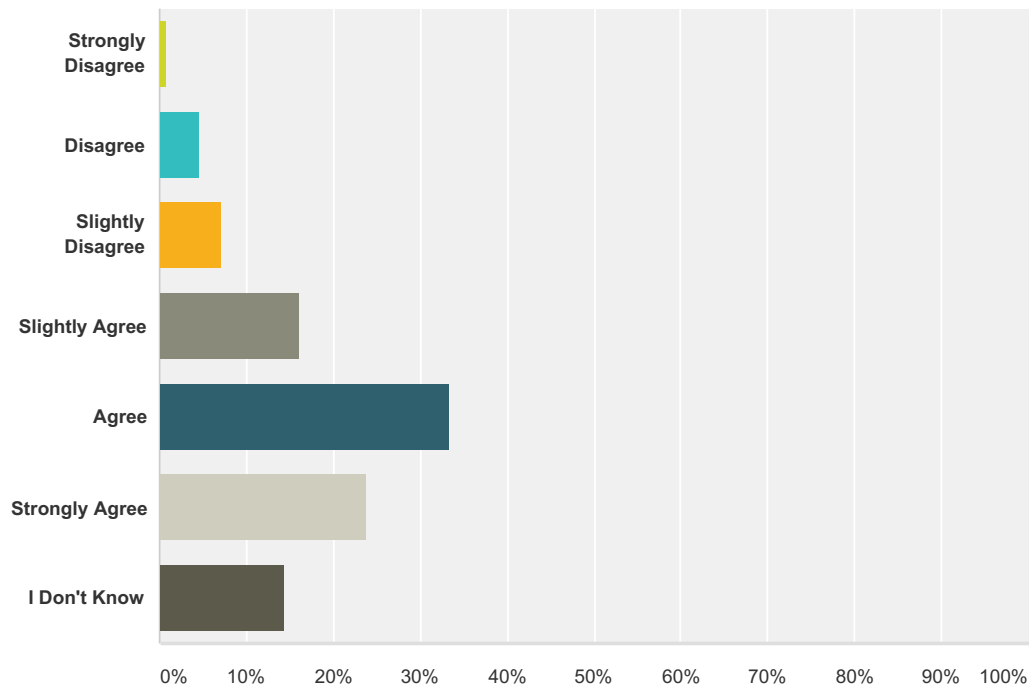

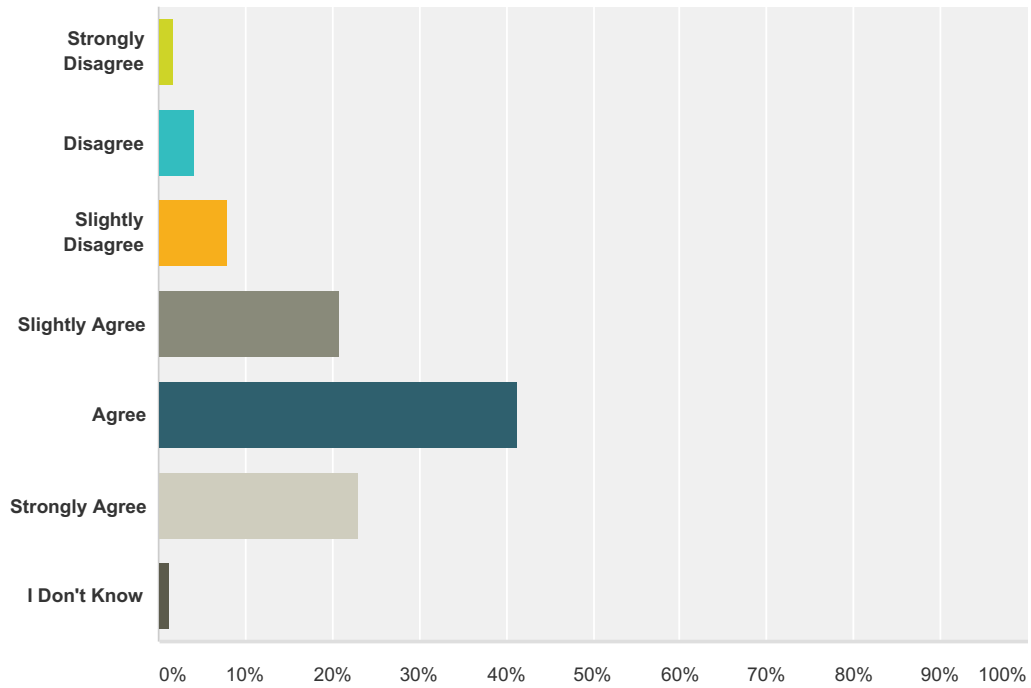

Q25 Most of the congregation sings.

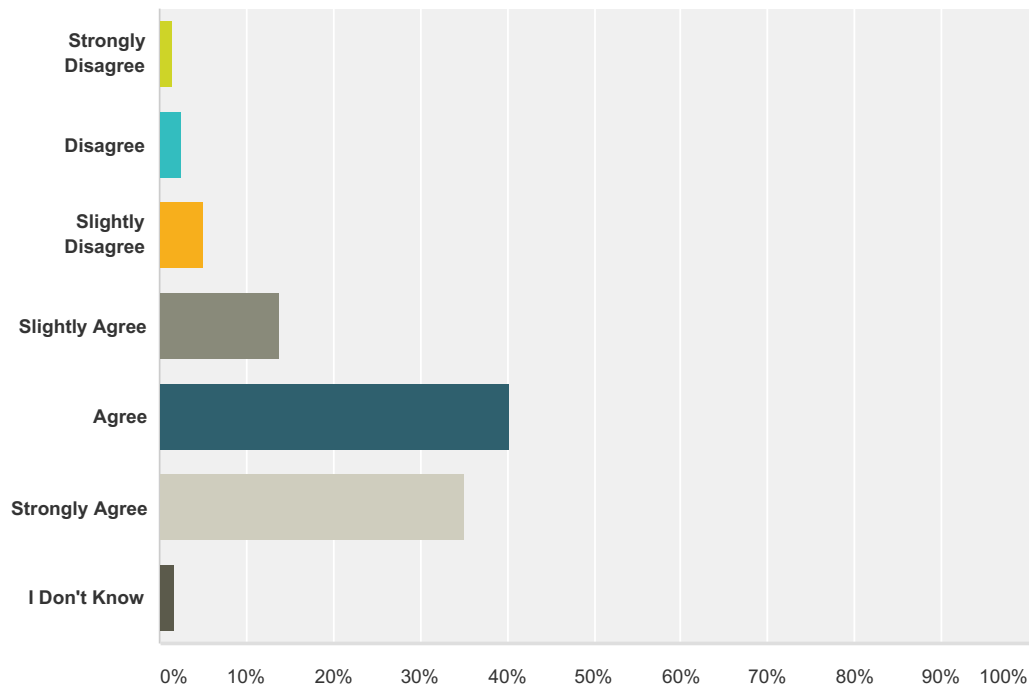

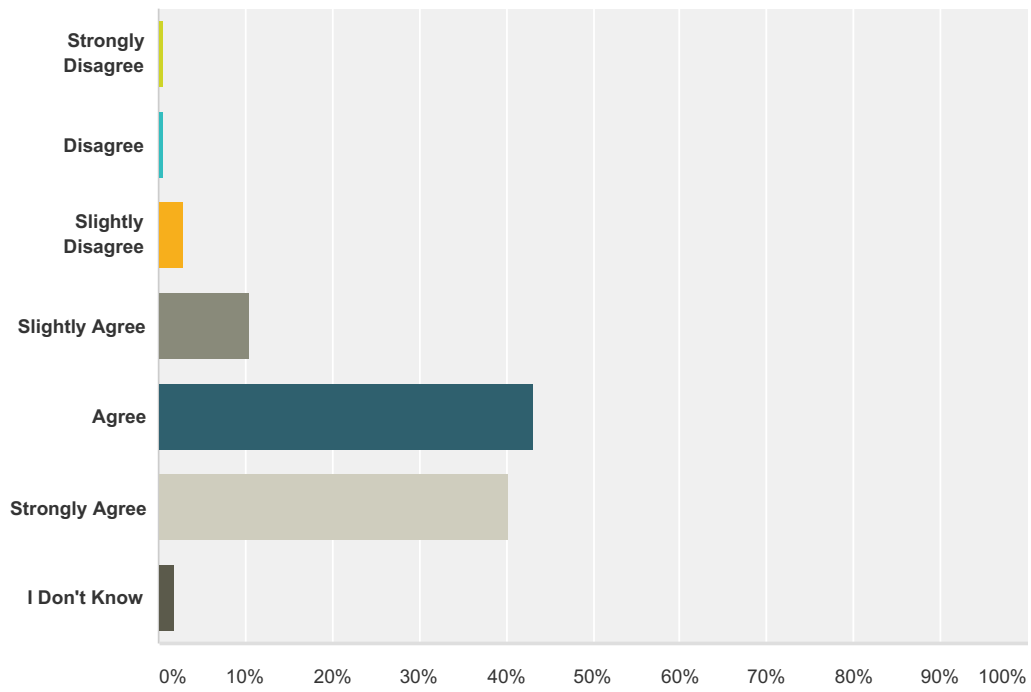

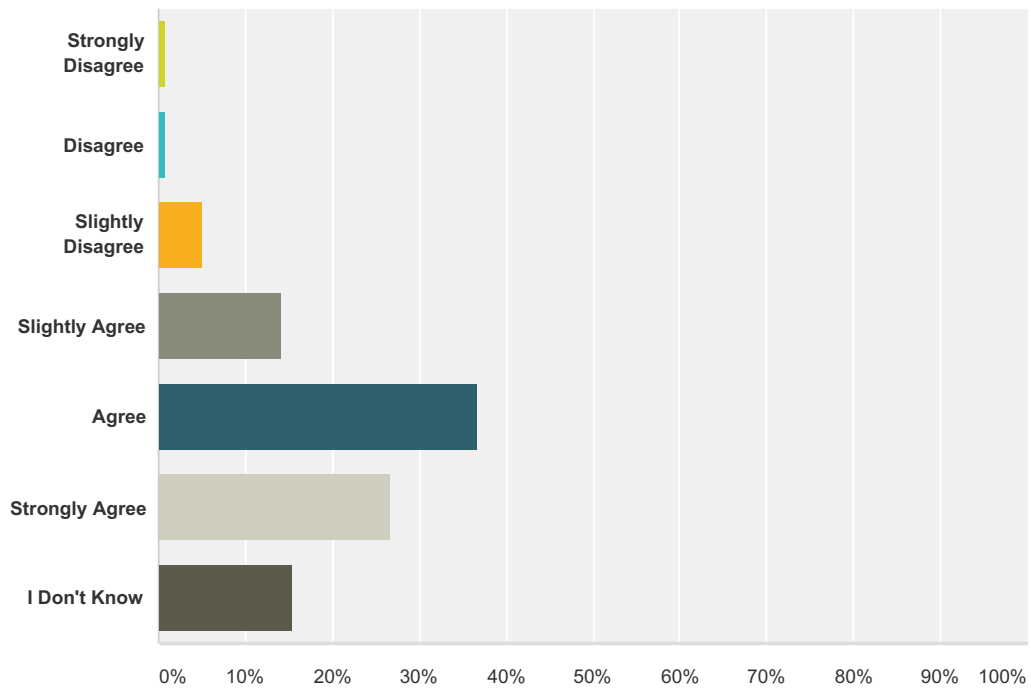

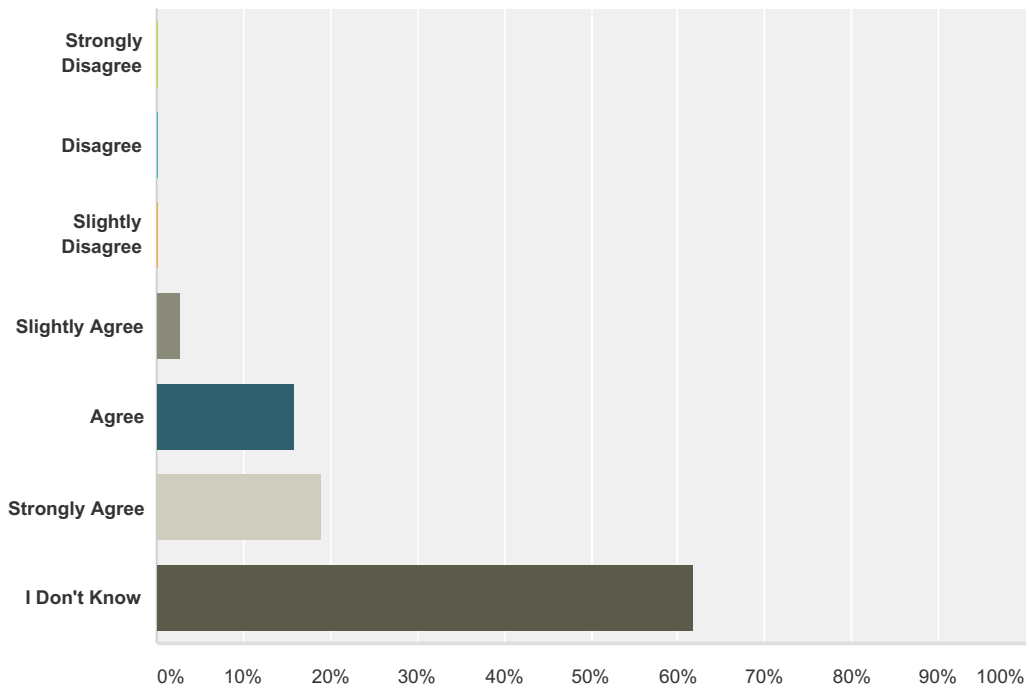

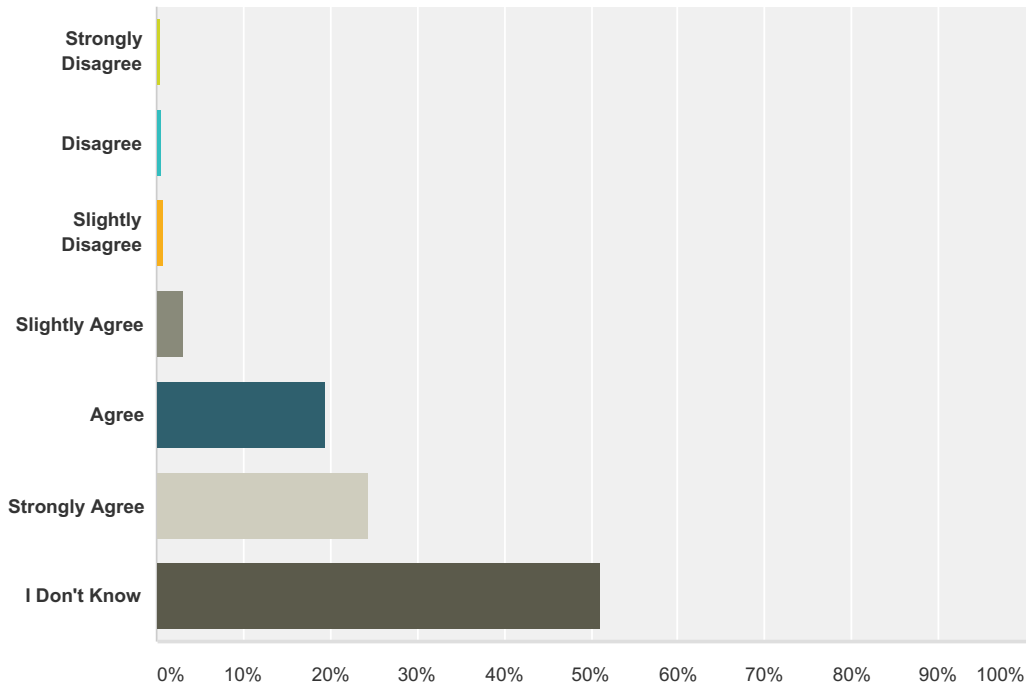

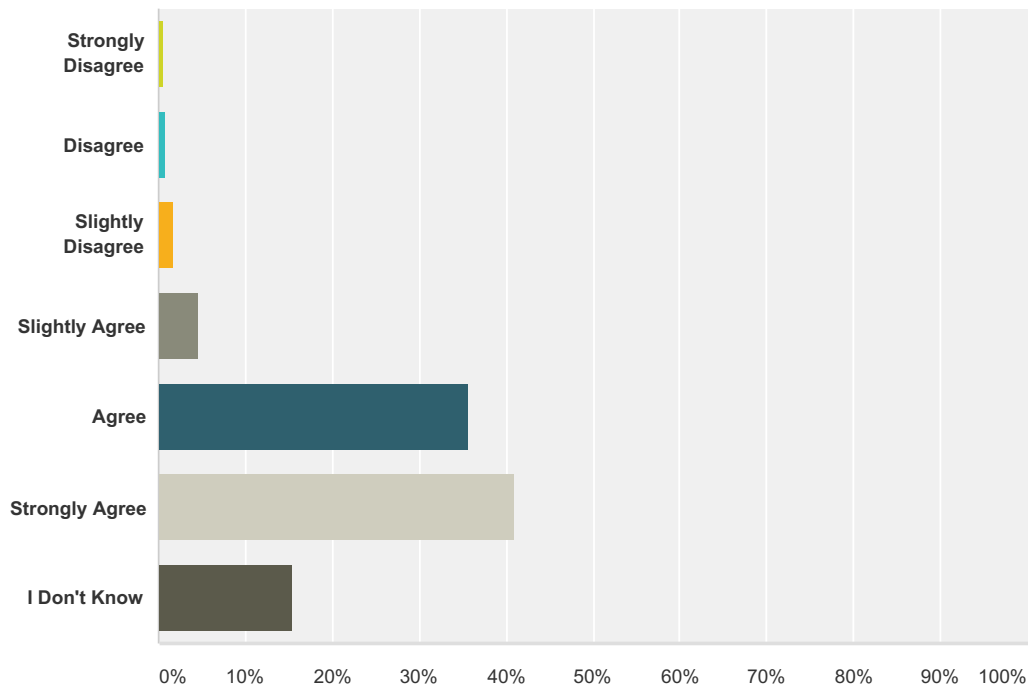

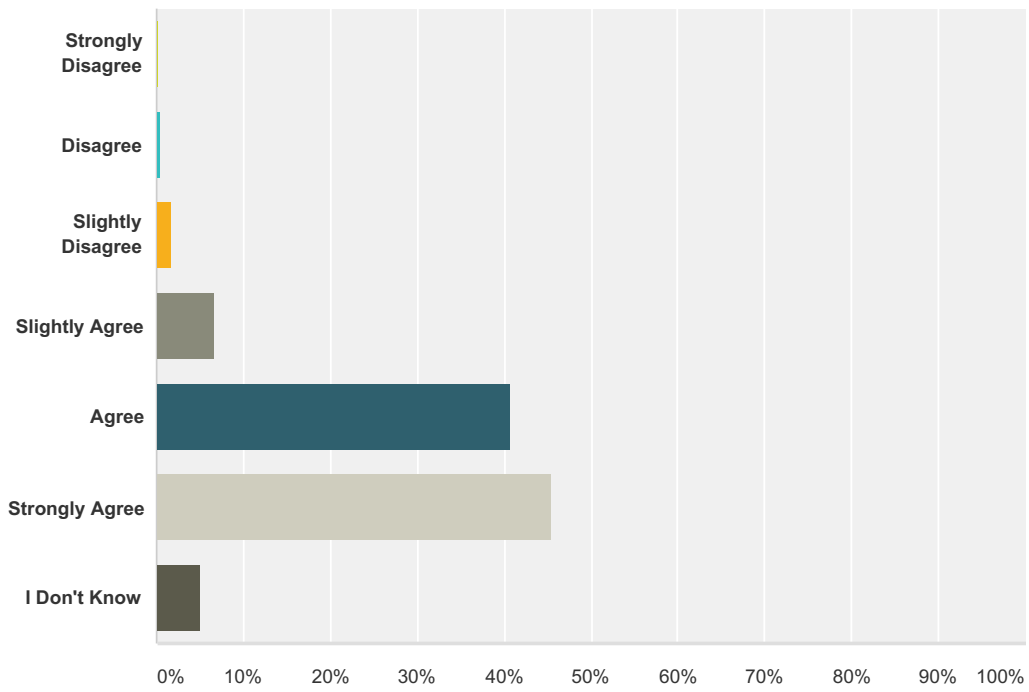

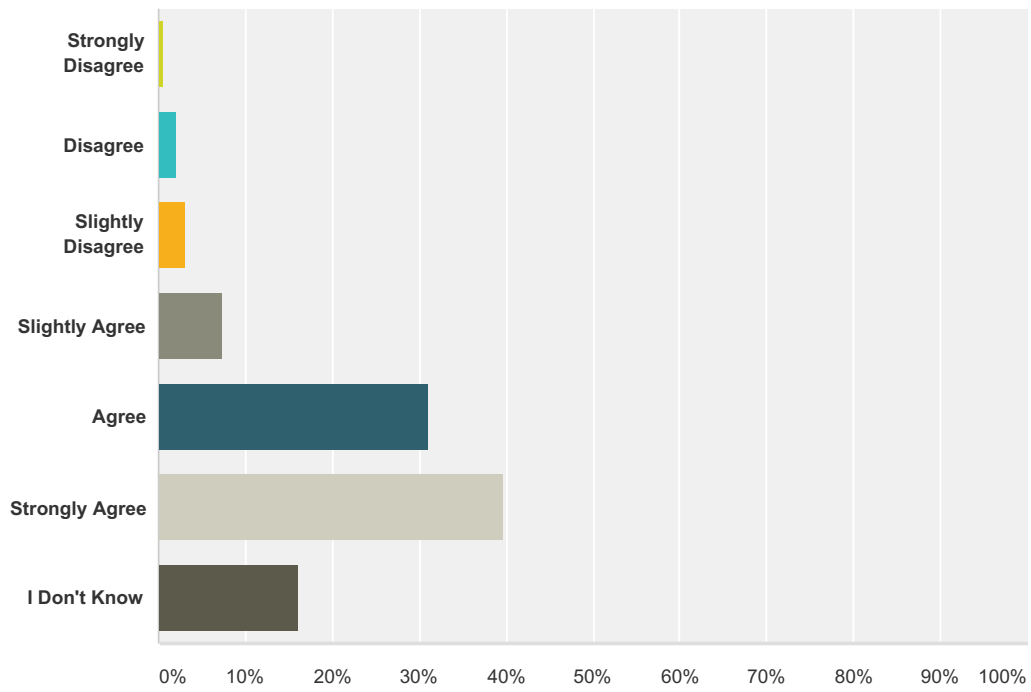

Q66 I feel responsible for inviting others to the Lord.

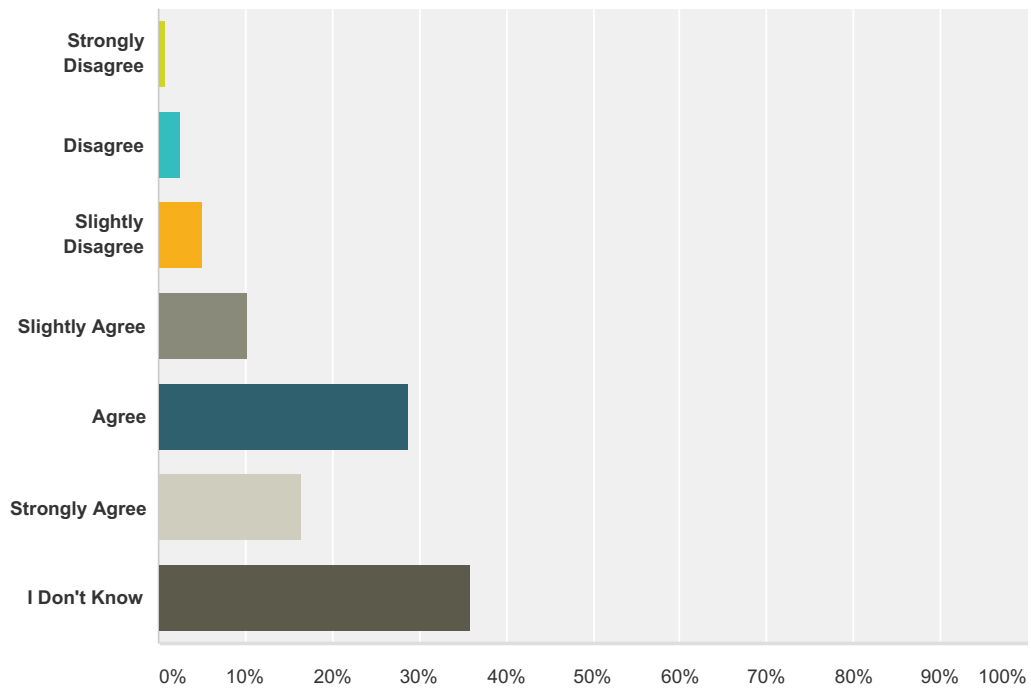

Q67 The Parish provides sufficient formal evangelization programs.

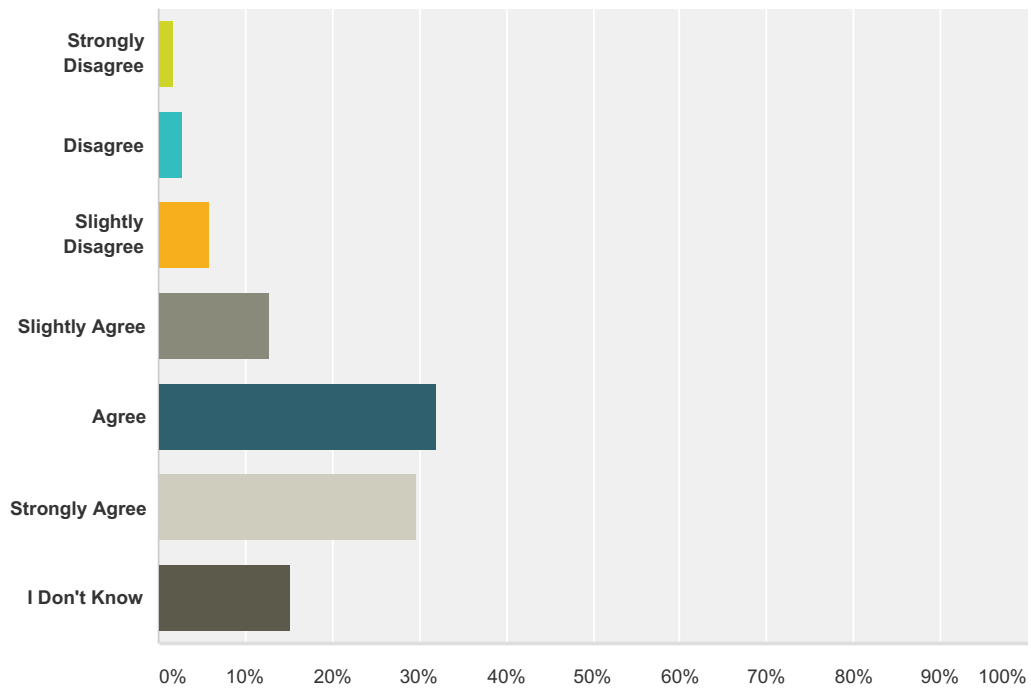

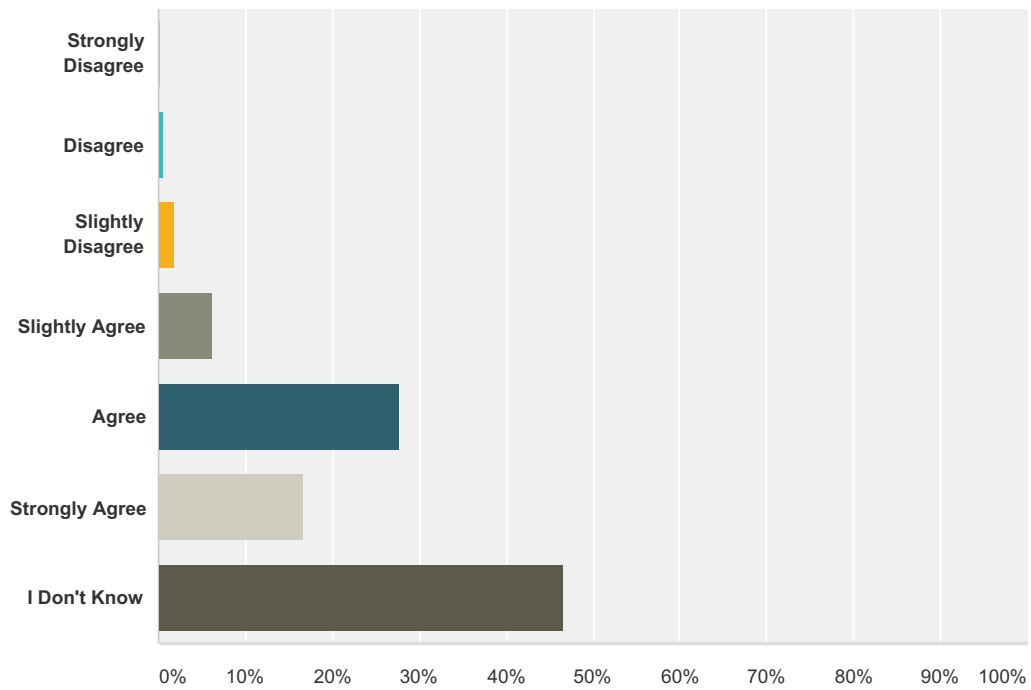

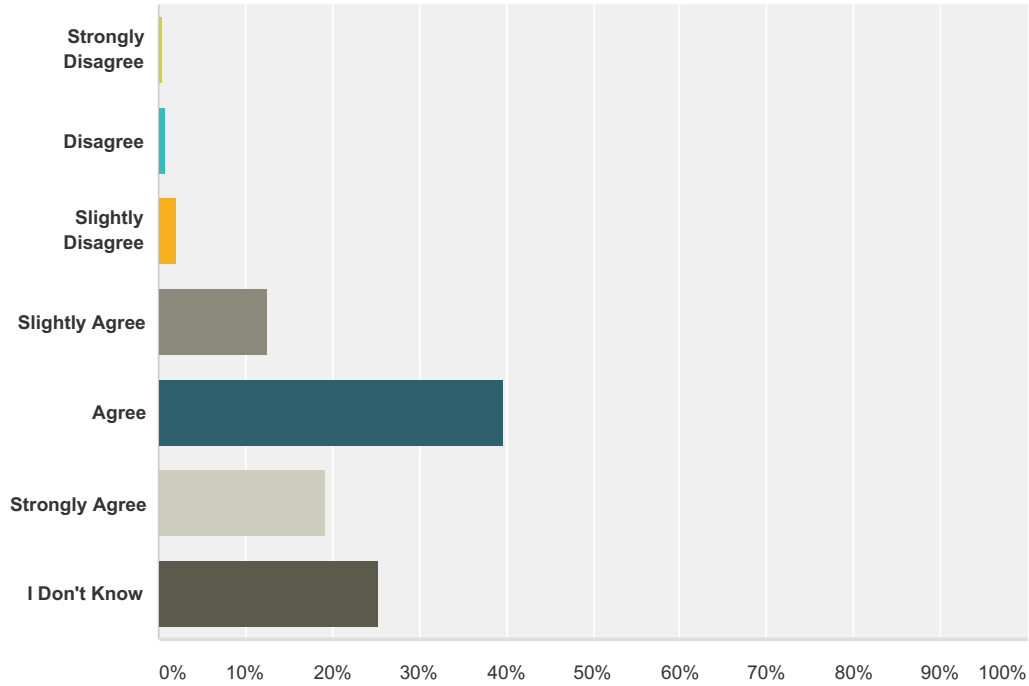

Q71 Parishioners respond when invited to volunteer for various Parish service programs.

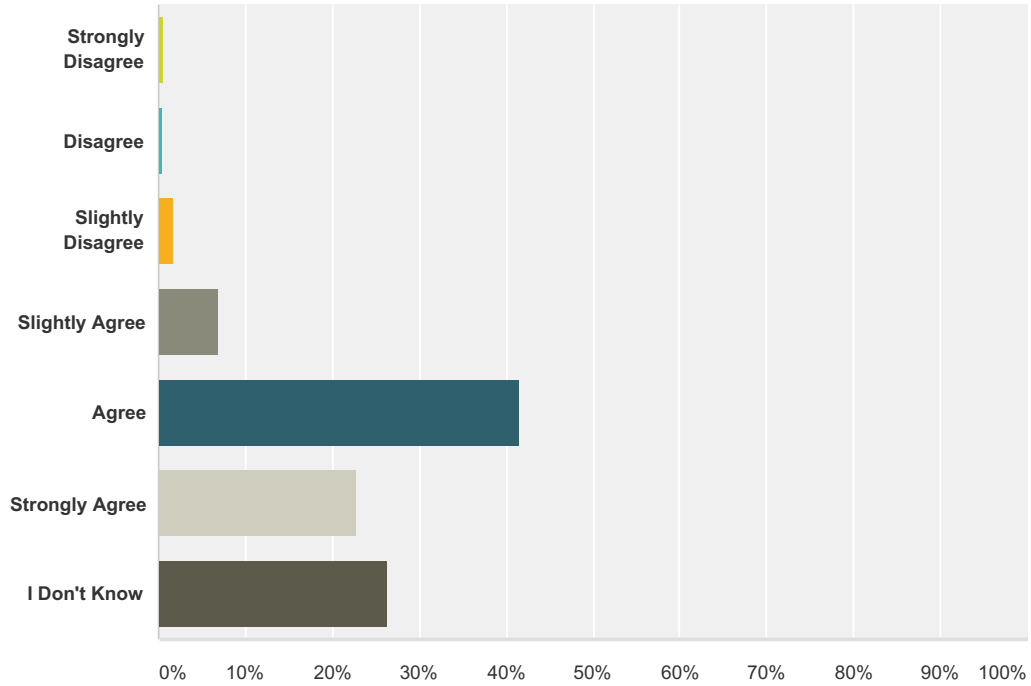

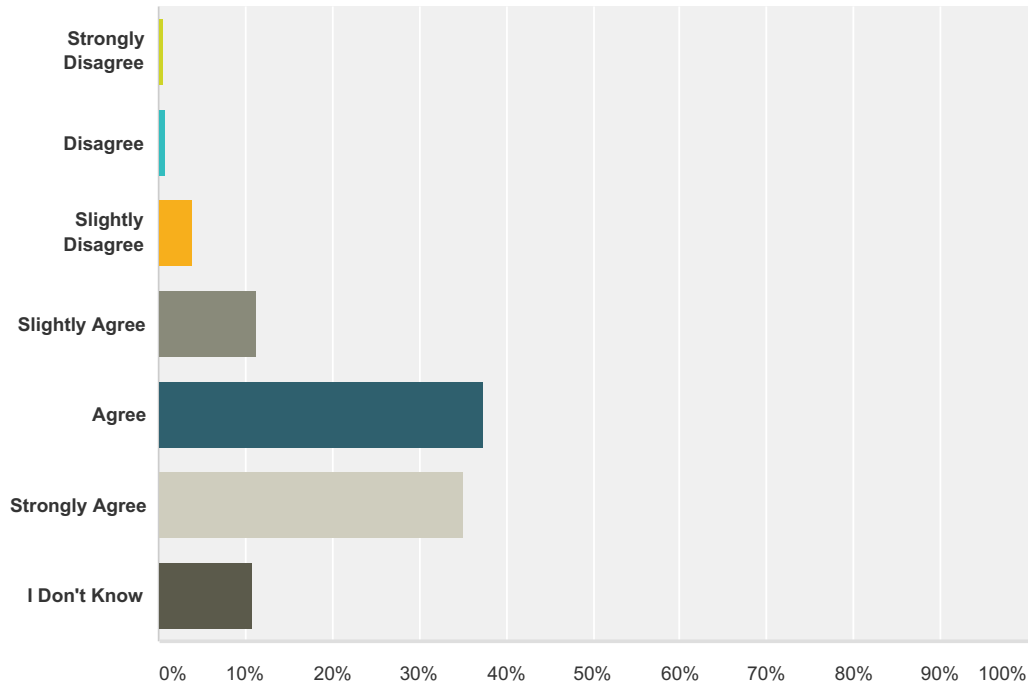

Q73 The Parish raises the awareness of Catholic social teaching (e.g. peace, justice, human development, respect for life, care for the environment).

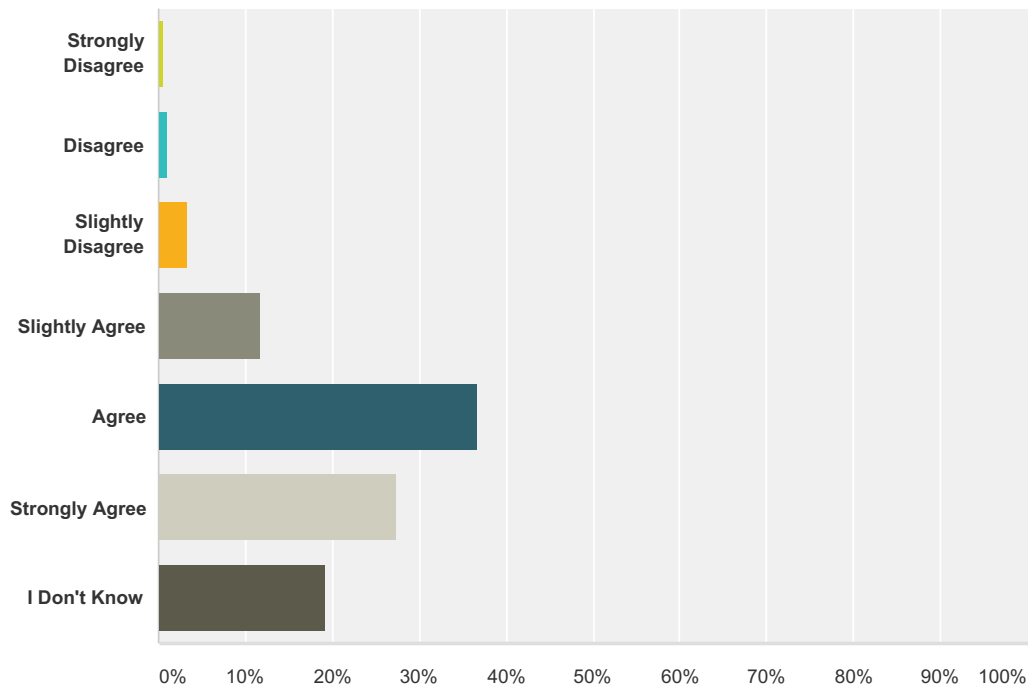

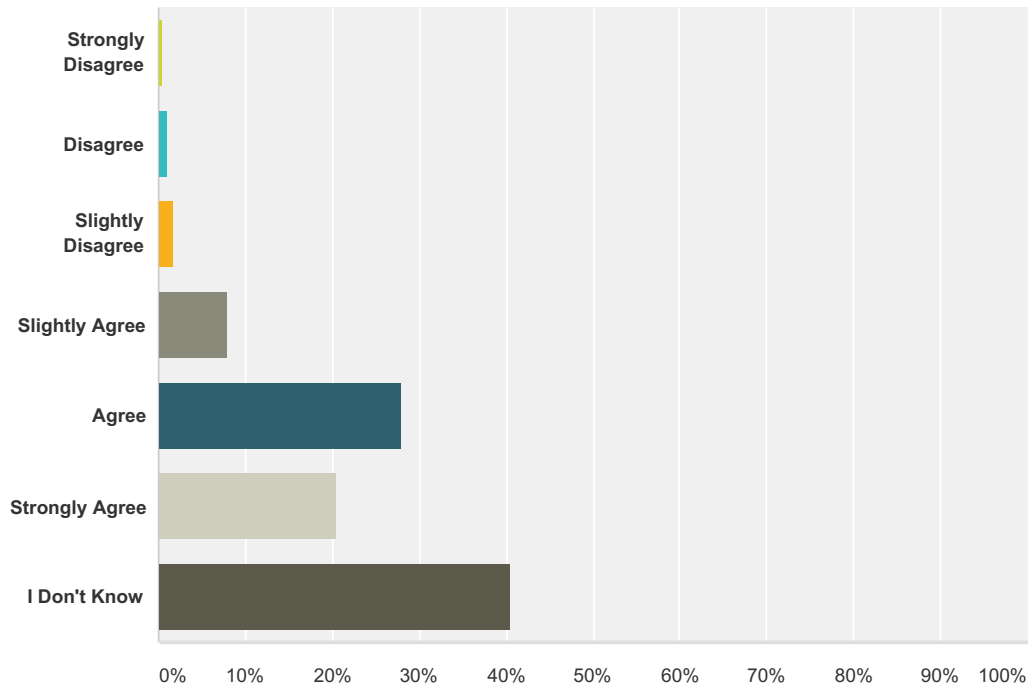

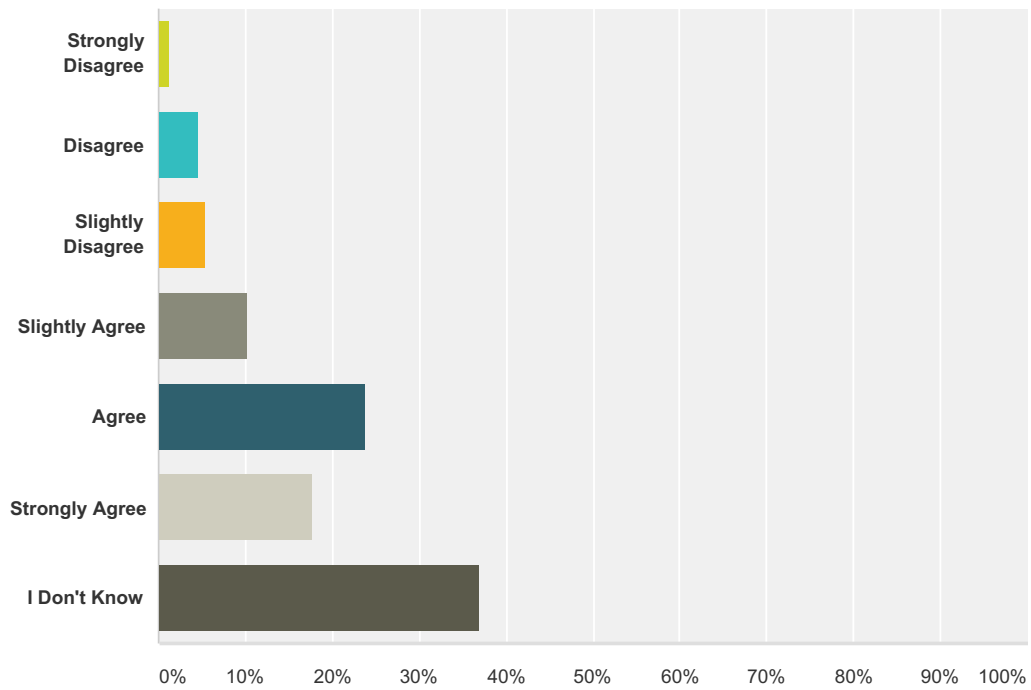

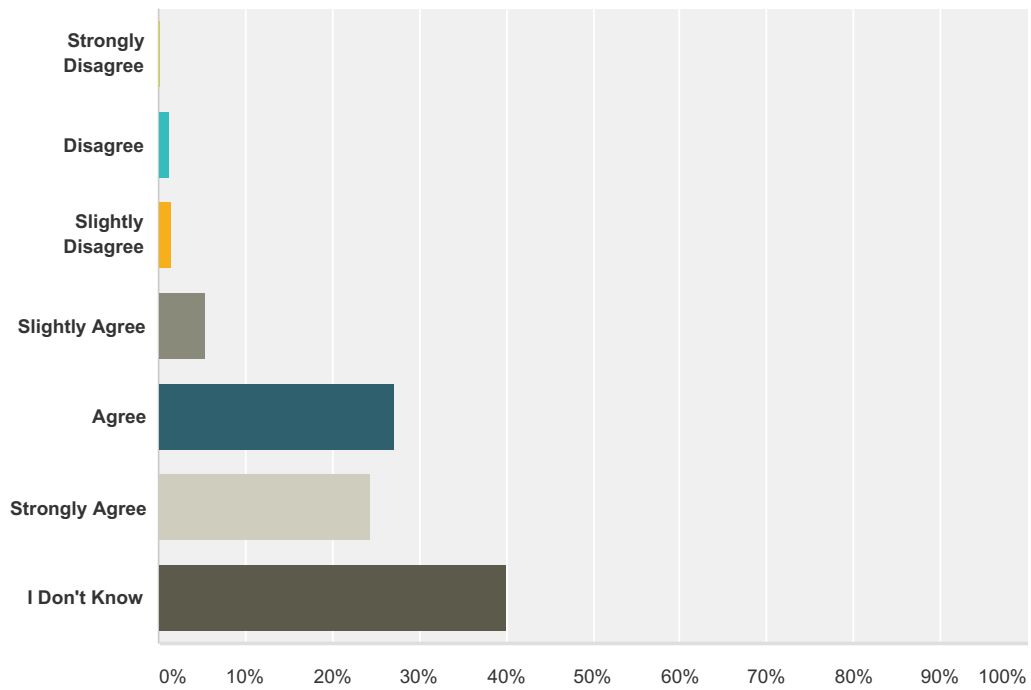

Q77 The Parish opens its facilities to community groups for meetings.

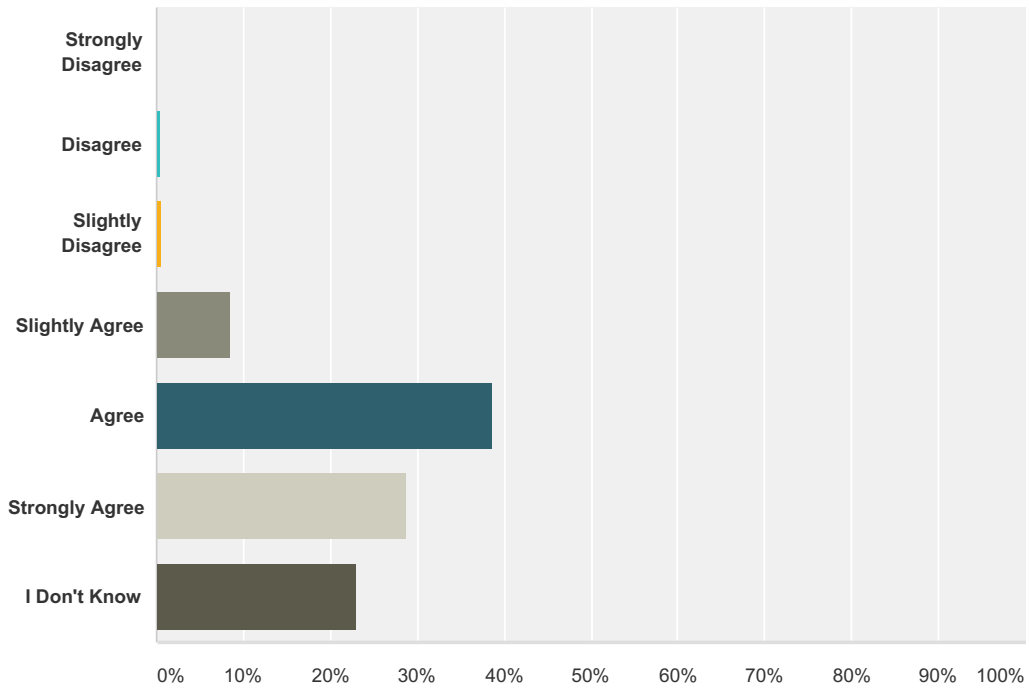
